

Junk Silver — Tally & Reference

Count your U.S. 90%, 40% and war-nickel silver, then value it at today's silver spot.

Silver quarter	1964 & earlier (90%)	0.1808
Silver half dollar	1964 & earlier (90%)	0.3617
Silver dollar	Morgan / Peace (90%)	0.7734
40% half dollar	Kennedy 1965-1970	0.1479
War nickel	1942-1945 (35%)	0.0563

Shortcut: \$1 of face value in 90% silver holds about 0.715 troy oz.
